Biography: Dr. Anna Armitage is a broadly trained community ecologist with over 20 years of experience working in coastal wetlands. Her research utilizes multivariate, interdisciplinary field studies to study trophic interactions and anthropogenic impacts in coastal wetland habitats, including marshes, mangroves, and seagrasses. Her current research projects include studies about the development of food webs in restored coastal wetlands and on ecological interactions and processes in the mangrove-marsh ecotone and other coastal habitats.
